

ORDINANCE 2005 - 14

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 71-06, WHICH REDUCED THE SIZE OF THE BAR MEASUREMENT OF SEINING AND GILL NETS, POCKET NETS OR ANY OTHER KINDS OF NETS, AND REGULATED THE LENGTH OF SUCH NETS AND PROHIBITED THE LEAVING OF REFUSE ON THE BEACHES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board has found it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that Ordinance 71-06, be rescinded.




