ORDINANCE 2005 - 58

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 94-18, WHICH PROVIDED FOR THE INSTALLATION AND PLACEMENT OF FIRE HYDRANTS; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION IV. APPEAL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County to amend Ordinance 94-18.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 25th day of July, 2005, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 94-18 shall be amended as follows:

- 1. IV. APPEAL. The decision of the spacing of fire hydrants may be appealed to the Board of County Commissioners within thirty (30) days of the Public Safety Director Fire Chief or his designee determining the spacing requirements. The Board should schedule the appeal at its next regularly scheduled meeting upon receipt of the appeal.
- 2. <u>V. EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the

Secretary of State.
