ORDINANCE NO. 2010- 07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA REZONING APPROXIMATELY 1.01 ACRES OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF S.R. 200/A1A IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO, AND WEST OF, THE YULEE POST OFFICE, FROM OPEN RURAL (OR) TO COMMERCIAL PROFESSIONAL OFFICE (CPO); PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, John C. Featherston, trustee (the Louise Flood Trust), owner of the real property described in this Ordinance, filed Application R10-002 for a rezoning and reclassification of the property from Open Rural (OR) to Commercial Professional Office (CPO); and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Board, after due notice conducted a public hearing on June 1, 2010 and voted to recommend approval of the rezoning request (R10-002) to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the above recommendations, the Commission finds that such rezoning is consistent with the overall Comprehensive Land Use Plan as proposed and the orderly development of the County of Nassau, Florida, and the specific area; and

WHEREAS, the proposed CPO zoning complies with the underlying Future Land Use Map (FLUM) designation of Commercial; and

WHEREAS, public notice of this rezoning has been provided in accordance with Chapter 125, Florida Statutes and the Nassau County Land Development Code.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS: That the proposed rezoning to Commercial Professional Office (CPO) is generally consistent with the goals, objectives and policies of the Nassau County Comprehensive Plan Polices, in particular 1.02.05(c), 1.02.03, and 1.09.02.

SECTION 2. PROPERTY REZONED: The real property described in Section 3 is rezoned and reclassified to Commercial Professional Office (CPO); Upon the effective date of the ordinance, the Growth Management Department is authorized to amend the Official Zoning Map to reflect this change.

SECTION 3. OWNER AND DESCRIPTION: The land rezoned by this Ordinance is owned by the Louise Flood Trust of Jacksonville, Florida and is identified by the following tax identification number, graphic illustration and legal description:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A portion of Section 44, Township 2 North, Range 27 East, Nassau County, Florida, being the residue of the lands described in Deed Book 192, Page 371 of the Public Records of said Nassau County, Florida, more particularly described as follows:

Begin at a point located on the northerly right-of-way line of State Road 200 (A-1-A) at Station 143 + 50.00 said point being 32.25 feet Northerly from the centerline of construction of the left roadway as shown on Department of Transportation map of Section 74040-2504 recorded in Plat Book 5, Page 23, of the Public Records of Nassau County, Florida:

Thence North 88° 08′ 25″ East along said Northerly right-of-way line a distance of 83.81 feet to the point of beginning: thence North 66° 02′ 22″ East a distance of 126.83 feet to a point; thence North 13° 40′ 21″ West a distance of 313.90 feet to a point; thence South 72° 01′ 07″ West a distance of 148.02 feet to a point; thence South 17° 40′ 54″ East a distance of 326.23 feet back to the point of beginning, being an area of 1.01 acres, more or less.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective after filing with the Secretary of State.
