ORDINANCE NO. 2012-<u>17</u>

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CHARGING OF FEES FOR EMERGENCY AND NON-EMERGENCY RESCUE SERVICES PROVIDED; ENABLING THE ESTABLISHMENT BY RESOLUTION OF FEES AND ASSOCIATED COLLECTION POLICIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has deemed it necessary to protect the health and welfare of the citizens and businesses of Nassau County to institute both emergency and non-emergency rescue service, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that fees and collection policies associated with rescue service be established and adopted by Resolution of the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that :

- 1. The Board hereby enacts the following provisions related to fees and collection policies associated with Rescue services provided:
 - A. The Nassau County Board of County Commissioners may establish fees for Rescue related services provided. Said fees shall be established by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners.
 - B. The Nassau County Board of County Commissioners may establish policies associated with the collection of Rescue provided services. Said policies shall be established by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners.
