

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, It is deemed wise and expedient to suggest to the State Road Department a change in order of priority of construction on certain secondary roads in Nassau County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, a group of interested citizens from the Hilliard-Callahan area feel that the roads set up under the Chairman's letter to the State Road Department under date of June 19, 1945 should be changed in the following manner, to-wit:

Roads heretofore designated as No. 6 and No. 3 be substituted in the place of road No. 2 in order of priority of construction

and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that this road is of great importance to the above community,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners in and for Nassau County, Florida, that the State Road Department be requested to construct said road as early as possible from any funds available for such purposes.
