

RESOLUTION FOR THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Nassau County did by warranty deed dated June 18, 1931, and recorded in Deed Book 56 at Page 208 of the Public Records of Nassau County, Florida, acquire for borrow pit purposes the following described property, to-wit:

One lot of land commencing at iron stake about Sixty-four (64') feet from crossing on the Seaboard Air Line Railroad, South of the Twenty-eight (28) mile post on said Railroad, then running in a Southwestern direction about 840 feet to land now owned by one Charley Jackson, thence along line of said Charley Jackson about 600 feet, thence East to right-of-way of the said Railroad, thence North to Point of Beginning. Said lot contains about 20 acres more or less, said lot of land being in the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Thirty-one (31), Township Two (2) North, Range Twenty-five (25) East.

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that said property is no longer needed for County purposes and that it is to the best interest of the County that said land be sold for cash to the highest bidder after notice of such sale shall be published once a week for at least two weeks in the Nassau County Record, Callahan, Florida, a news-paper of general circulation published in Nassau County, calling for bids for the purchase of said property to be sold to the highest bidder therefor with the right of this Board of County Commissioners to reject all bids.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in meeting duly assembled, that the above described property be offered for sale to the highest bidder for cash.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a notice of the sale of said property be published in the Nassau County Record, Callahan, Florida, calling for bids for the purchase of said property to the highest

bidder for cash, said bids to be received and opened at 10:00 o'clock A. M. on April 11, 1962, in the meeting room of this Board at the Nassau County Court House in Fernandina Beach, Florida, said notice to state that this Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids for the purchase of said property. All in accordance with Section 125.35 and 125.36, Florida Statutes.
