WHEREAS, the only privately owned system subject to said Statute wifhin Nassau County is the water system owned by Florida Public Utilities Company now operating under a franchise granted by the City of Fernandina Beach, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the City of Fernandina Beach, Florida, has adopted a resolution requesting this Board of County Commissioners to adopt a resolution placing Nassau County under the provisions of said Statute so that The Florida Public Utilities Commission can supervise and regulate the operation of said water system, and

WHEREAS, this Board, after due deliberation, has determined that it is to the best interest of said County that the provisions of said Chapter 367, Florida Statutes, shall become effective in Nassau County, Florida, and that the regulation of privately owned water and sewer systems in Nassau County shall be administered by the Florida Public Utilities Commission, whose function it is to regulate and control privately owned utilities within the State of Florida, this Board finding that said Florida Public Utilities Commission is 'eminently qualified to perform this function in a manner greatly superior to that of any local Governmental Agency within Nassau County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in special meeting duly assembled, that the provisions of Chapter 367, Florida Statutes, shall become effective in Nassau County, Florida, immediately, and it is hereby declared that Nassau County, Florida, is subject to the provisions of said Statute.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be immediately transmitted to The Florida Public Utilities Commission at Tallahassee, Florida, as required by said Statute.

WHEREAS, the Florida Public Utilities Commission is created for the purpose of establishing rates for utilities and are experts in this field, having now the sole jurisdiction for the fixing of electric rates for privately owned utility companies, and it is the feeling of this Commission that in justice to the consumers of water in this City as well as the Florida Public Utilities Company who owns and operates said water facility in this City, that the rate making
