

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING INSTALLATION
OF HEATING SYSTEM IN THE NASSAU
COUNTY JAIL.

WHEREAS, Good Housekeeping Gas Company, a Georgia Corporation with a place of business in the Village of Yulee, Nassau County, Florida, did enter into a contract with Nassau County under date of January 7, 1964, for the installation of a heating system in the Nassau County Jail in the City of Fernandina Beach, Nassau County, Florida, for the total price of \$3,874.35.

WHEREAS, the Sheriff of Nassau County, H. J. Youngblood, has written this Board a letter stating that the installation of said heating system by Good Housekeeping Gas Company has been completed in a good workmanlike manner, and the members of this Board of County Commissioners have inspected said installation of heating system in the Nassau County Jail and the work performed and materials furnished under said contract and find that the contractor has fully performed his contract and is entitled to payment due thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY in regular meeting duly assembled that the contract entered into between Good Housekeeping Gas Company and Nassau County under date of January 7, 1964, for the installation of a heating system in the Nassau County Jail described in the preamble hereof, has been fully performed by said Good Housekeeping Gas Company as Contractor and the work performed thereunder is hereby approved and said work accepted.

BE IT FURTHERRESOLVED that the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Nassau County, Florida, as Ex-Officio Clerk of this Board be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to pay to Good Housekeeping Gas Company the amount due under said contract in the aggregate sum of \$3,874.35.
