RESOLUTION NO. 100

A RESOLUTION SETTING FORTH THE FORM OF THE BALLOTS TO BE USED IN CONNECTION WITH THE HOLDING AND CONDUCTING OF THE SPECIAL TAX SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 1965.

SECTION 1. That the form of the ballots to be used in connection with the holding and conducting of the school district election to be held on Tuesday, November 2, 1965, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M., are to be in substantially the form as prescribed by law, same being Chapters 230 and 236, Florida Statutes, as amended.

SECTION 2. Substantially the following form of ballot shall be used:

- (a) To determine whether or not the School Trustees of Special Tax School District Number 1 of Nassau County, Florida, shall be abolished,
- (b) For election of school trustees, there being no trustees of said Special Tax School District Number 1 nominated as provided by law, namely, Chapters 230 and 236, Florida Statutes, as amended, therefore, no persons names will be placed upon the ballot for approval of trustees, and
- (c) For voting the levy in said special tax school district:


