WHEREAS, Expressway and Interstate Roads in the State have antiquated many of its Primary Roads and make necessary the modernization of existing Roads and the construction of additional connecting Roads, and

WHEREAS, it is imperative in the interest of public safety that adequate and sufficient highways be provided, and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Haydon Burns, Governor of our great State of Florida, has proposed Three Hundred Million Dollar Primary Highway Improvement Program, for the purpose of four-laning approximately 1241 miles of crowded Primary Highways in the State of Florida, during the next few years, and

WHEREAS, such action will be beneficial to the entire State of Florida,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Board of Directors of the Fernandina Beach Chamber of Commerce, Fernandina Beach, Florida, hereby goes on record as approving Governor Haydon Burns' proposed Road Bond Issue,
