

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE ROAD DEPARTMENT OF FLORIDA TO PLACE MATERIALS ON STATE ROAD NO. 200 (U. S. HIGHWAY NO. 301) BETWEEN CALLAHAN AND BALDWIN, FLORIDA, TO REDUCE SKIDDING.

WHEREAS, State Road No. 200 (U. S. Highway No. 301) is an undivided two way traffic State primary road between the Towns of Callahan, Florida, and Baldwin, Florida, and is a heavily traveled road forming an intregal part of the highway system of Florida, and

WHEREAS, numerous accidents occur on this highway, many of which are fatal although it is a spacious highway with wide shoulders and in excellent condition from all appearances except that when said road is wet it becomes more slippery than is usual for such type of roads and is highly susceptible to skidding, and

WHEREAS, this condition has been called to the attention of this Board by law enforcement officers and others who have occasion to use said road constantly and who investigate accidents occurring on said road, that this slippery condition exists when said road is wet and that it is their opinion that many accidents occur because of this slippery condition, and

WHEREAS, this Board feels that the dangerous condition of this road during wet weather should be called to the attention of the State Road Department of Florida, with the request that a suitable topping or surface be added to said road to minimize or prevent said road from being slippery when wet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in meeting duly assembled, that the State Road Department of Florida be, and it is hereby, requested to place a topping or surface on said State Road No. 200

(U. S. Highway No. 301), from Callahan, Florida, to Baldwin, Florida, to prevent or minimize the slippery condition of said road when it is wet.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be transmitted to The Honorable Floyd B. Bowen, Chairman of the State Road Department of Florida, Tallahassee, Florida; The Honorable C. William Beaufort, Florida State Road Board Member, Second District, Jacksonville, Florida, and The Honorable James A. Brewer, District Engineer, State Road Department, Lake City, Florida.
