

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING
MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON A
CERTAIN COUNTY ROAD IN
NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau
County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County
Roads under Section 317.24, Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board, after full and careful investigation,
has determined that it is to the best interest of public safety
and welfare that maximum speed limit of thirty (30) miles per hour
for all vehicular travel upon a road in Nassau County known as
Edwards Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in Special meeting duly
assembled, that the maximum speed of all vehicles shall not exceed
thirty (30) miles per hour upon a County Road known as Edwards Road.
