

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A CHANGE
IN THE HOURS OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES ON SUNDAY.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners being desirous to respect the hours of worship of churches on Sunday, does, with the passing of this resolution, amend the present existing resolution as recorded in Minutes Book 14, pages 196-7, as follows:

Alcoholic beverages may be sold, consumed or permitted to be sold or consumed in any place holding a license under the State Beverage Department of Florida and within the territory of Nassau County, Florida, not included within a municipality within said County, from and during the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 2:00 o'clock A.M. of the following day, except, however, no alcoholic beverages may be sold, consumed or served or permitted to be sold, consumed or served in any place holding a license under the State Beverage Department of Florida, within the territory of Nassau County, Florida, and not within any municipality of Nassau County, Florida, between the hours of 2:00 o'clock A.M. Sunday and 2:00 o'clock P.M. Sunday.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect on the 21st day of May, 1967, at 2:00 o'clock A.M.
