RESOLUTION NO. 7
RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING
MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT UPON
BUCK OWENS ROAD IN NASSAU
COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County Roads under Section 317.233 (2), Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board, after full and careful investigation and in conformity to criteria promulgated by the State Road Department, has determined that in the best interest of public safety and welfare, the maximum speed limit of thirty (30) miles per hour for all vehicular travel be established upon the following county road in Nassau County, Florida, to-wit: Buck Owens Road, located directly North of the Federal Aviation Control Center in Hilliard, Florida, and that clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limit be posted in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zone.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled, that the maximum speed of all vehicles shall not exceed thirty (30) miles per hour upon the County road known as Buck Owens Road, located directly North of the Federal Aviation Control Center in Hilliard, Florida, and that the County Engineer is hereby directed to obtain clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limit and to post such signs in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zone.
