A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE  
CONCEPT OF FEDERAL REVENUE  
SHARING AND ENCOURAGING EARLY  
CONGRESSIONAL ACTION ON ENACT-  
MENT OF A FEDERAL PROGRAM

WHEREAS, it is becoming increasingly difficult for City, County and State Government to provide necessary services with revenues currently available, and

WHEREAS, the primary source of revenue for governmental purposes is the Federal Income Tax levied and collected by the Federal Government, and

WHEREAS, the current administration at the Federal Government level has proposed a Federal Revenue Sharing Program to assist local governments in the provisions of services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in regular monthly session assembled this 9th day of March, 1971, that it does hereby strongly endorse the principle of Federal Revenue Sharing and encourages the Ninety-Second Congress to enact legislation establishing such a program at the earliest opportunity.
