

RESOLUTION NO. 73

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN SOUTHERN RAILROAD SYSTEM AND NASSAU COUNTY FLORIDA,

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, held on the 9th day of November, 1971, the following was ordered and spread upon the minutes:

"It is hereby ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that the form of agreement between the said County and the Southern Railroad System, dated by the provisions of which the said Railroad Company grants to the said County an easement or right of way, within the limits therein set out, for relocating and maintaining a public road or street crossing (including the usual appurtenances, such as a paved roadway, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, shoulders, slopes, fills, cuts and drainage facilities) at grade across the right of way and track or tracks of the Southern Railroad System at a grade crossing located 2160 feet east of Mile Post 246 between Valdosta, Georgia, and Jacksonville, Florida in Nassau County, Florida, as particularly described in said agreement attached to and made a part of said agreement, be and the same is hereby approved."

"Further that the Chairman and Clerk of said Board are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement in the name and on behalf of said County.
