

RESOLUTION NO. 101

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU
COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO
AN EASEMENT OF RIGHT OF WAY FOR
CONSTRUCTING A RAILROAD CROSSING
ON NOAH SIKES ROAD

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, held on the 13th day of June, 1972, the following was ordered and spread upon the minutes:

"It is hereby ordered by the Board of County, Florida, that the form of agreement between the said County and the Seaboard Coast Line Railroad Company, dated December 29, 1970, by the provisions of which the said Railroad Company grants to the said County an easement or right of way, within the limits therein set out, for constructing and maintaining a public road or street crossing (including the usual appurtenances, such as a paved roadway, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, shoulders, slopes, fills, cuts and drainage facilities) at grade across the right of way and track or tracks of the Seaboard Coast Line Railroad Company at a point 2475 feet south of Mile Post A-617 near Hilliard, Florida, as particularly described in said agreement and as more fully shown on the print attached to and made a part of said agreement, be and the same is hereby approved."


"Further that the Chairman and Clerk of said Board are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement in the name and on behalf of said County."
