RESOLUTION APPROVING CONSTRUCTION OF
NASSAU COUNTY HEALTH CENTER BUILDING
AT CALLAHAN AND ACCEPTING THE SAME

WHEREAS, Peeples Construction Company Inc., of Jacksonville, Florida, did enter into a contract with Nassau County on the 1st day of June, A. D. 1971, for the construction of a County Building at Callahan, to house the Nassau County Health Center at Callahan, for the total price of \$ 78,795.00, and

WHEREAS, the members of this Board have inspected the completed building, and have received from the contractor an affidavit stating that all outstanding labor and material liens or possible liens against the property have been paid, and have found that the contractor has fully performed his contract and is entitled to payment due thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY in regular meeting duly assembled that the contract entered into between Peeples Construction Company, Inc., of Jacksonville, Florida, and Nassau County for the construction of the Nassau County Health Center at Callahan, has been fully performed by the said Peeples Construction Company, Inc., as Contractor, and the construction thereunder is hereby approved and accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Nassau County, Florida, as Ex-officio Clerk of this Board be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to Peeples Construction Company, Inc., the aggregate sum of \$ 7,739.89, balance due upon receipt of warranties covering plumbing, electrical and air conditioning.


