

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the workload of the Clerk of Nassau County has increased greatly due to the implementation of The Amendment of Article five of the Constitution of Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Board is in receipt of a letter from Marion W. Gooding, Circuit Judge, requesting that Fifteen hundred (\$1500) Dollars a month from certain sources be allocated for the new volume of work in the Clerk's office, and

Whereas, D. O. Oxley has been forced to increase his office staff and his responsibilities in order to insure the efficient handling of the Clerk's new duties under Article five.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County as follows:

1. That the office of the Clerk shall receive Fifteen hundred (\$1500) Dollars a month more in fees for the proper implementation of the Amendments to Article five as implemented by the legislature on January 1 of this year.

2. That D. O. Oxley shall have an increase in his salary of \$500.00 Dollars per month, to be paid from these same fees.
