RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF COUNTY LICENSE TO PAT JOHNSON TO ENGAGE IN PALMISTRY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

That this Board finds that the applicant is properly qualified to receive a permit and does hereby order that such permit be delivered to the said Pat Johnson permitting her to engage in the practice of Palmistry in the Town of Callahan, Florida,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Tax Collector of Nassau County is hereby authorized, upon payment of the necessary license tax, to issue to the said Pat Johnson, a license to engage in the practice of Palmistry as applied for,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That a copy of this resolution be delivered to the Tax Collector of Nassau County and that a copy thereof be delivered to the applicant, and the original retained by the Clerk.
