

RESOLUTION NO. 124

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY,
FLORIDA, RELATING TO DREDGE-FILL
PERMIT FOR ELWOOD BRANCH, LANCEFORD
CREEK AND LOFTON CREEK.

W H E R E A S, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has filed an application for a dredge-fill permit from the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida for proposed dredging and filling in Elwood Branch, Lanceford Creek and its adjoining marsh lands and in the adjoining swamp lands each side of Lofton Creek, and

W H E R E A S, a biological survey and an ecological study have been made by the Department of Natural Resources of the area to be dredged and filled and a copy of the report and findings of the Department of Natural Resources having been read into the record and duly considered, and

W H E R E A S, the Board has determined that the issuance of the dredge-fill permit will not be contrary to the public interest,

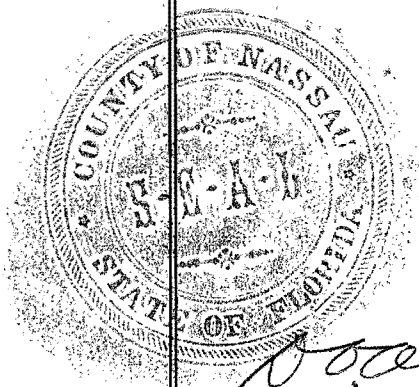
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida, that a dredge-fill permit is hereby granted to the State of Florida Department of Transportation for dredging and filling in Elwood Branch, Lanceford Creek and adjoining marsh lands and in the swamp lands adjoining Lofton Creek, said areas being located in (Lofton Creek - Section 38, Township 2 North, Range 27 East, Lanceford Creek - Township 2 North, Range 28 East, Elwood Branch - Township 2 North, Range 28 East), as delineated on the sketches attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that certified copies of this Resolution be forwarded to the State of Florida Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund and to the State of Florida Department of Transportation for consideration and approval.
