RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION SETTING LOAD LIMITS ON FELMOR ROAD

WHEREAS, Chapter 125 of the Florida Statutes establishes that the governing body of the County of Nassau shall have the power to provide and regulate road facilities, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the County of Nassau is the Board of County Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to adopt resolutions necessary for the exercise of its powers, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the County that load limits be placed on certain roads to insure their proper maintenance and control, and

WHEREAS, Felmor Road is a County owned and maintained road.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Felmor Road, located in the County of Nassau shall not have any vehicle travel on or pass over it which weighs in excess of eight (8) tons.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that anyone who does so shall be guilty of a misdemeanor in the third degree and shall be punished according to the laws of the State of Florida.
