

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, supports the comprehensive alcohol prevention control and treatment provided through governmental services, and believes that the Myers Act can be an effective means to combat alcoholism, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County is aware of the fact that the counties of Florida cannot afford the implementation and running of the program as proposed by the Florida Legislature,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida:

1. That the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County proposes that the financing of said program lies within the realm of taxation on alcoholic beverages for the explicit and specific purpose of financing comprehensive alcohol prevention control and treatment.
