RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE NASSAU COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS TO ENTER INTO AN INTRA-GOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT FOR PLANNING AND DELIVERY OF MANPOWER AND
RELATED PROGRAM SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor is proceeding to implement the
Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973 and

WHEREAS, the governments of Nassau and Duval counties are
currently being served on an area wide basis through the Jacksonville
Manpower Area Planning Council and wish to continue this approach to
planning and implementing Manpower and related programs under the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners
of Nassau County, Florida, that the ^{BOARD OF} COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
be authorized to enter into agreements with other units of local government
pursuant to the Florida intra-local cooperative Act of 1969, Section 163.01,
Florida Statutes (1971), for the purpose of planning and implementing a
coordinated program of Manpower and related services.
