

RESOLUTION

NO. 170

WHEREAS, Section 1 (e), Article VIII, of the Constitution of Florida provides that there shall be five County Commissioners Districts in each County, which Districts shall be numbered 1 to 5, inclusive, and shall be as nearly as possible equal in proportion to population, and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of Florida has interpreted said Constitutional provision as permitting the County Commissioners a reasonable discretion in taking into consideration the practical aspects of the development of the County from an economic standpoint and has indicated that other practical considerations might be considered in dividing the County into County Commissioners Districts, and

WHEREAS, the growth of Nassau County since 1956 has resulted in an uneven distribution of the population within the County Commissioners Districts, and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that in view of the area, population, and economic development of the County that the boundaries of the County Commissioners' Districts for Nassau County should be established and defined as hereinafter set forth in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in a meeting duly assembled on this 26th day of February, 1974, that the boundaries of the County Commissioners' Districts of Nassau County, Florida, be, and the same are, hereby designated and established as follows:

COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT NO. 1

Beginning at the point where a prolongation of the center line of Fourth (4th) Street intersects with the low water mark of the

Amelia River, thence proceed in a Southerly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Fourth (4th) Street to its intersection with the center line of Beech Staeet, thence in an Easterly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Beech Street to its intersection with the low water mark of Egans Creek, thence in a Southerly direction along the meanderings of Egans Creek and continue along the Fernandina Beach city limits to the intersection with a prolongation of the center line of Simmons Road, thence in an Easterly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Simmons Road to its intersection with the low water mark of the Atlantic Ocean, thence in a Northerly direction along the low water mark of the Atlantic Ocean to its intersection with the low water mark of the Cumberland Sound, thence in a Westerly direction along the low water mark of the Cumberland Sound and around the Northern end of Amelia Island to the intersection with the low water mark of the Amelia River, thence in a Southerly direction along the low water mark of the Amelia River to the prolongation of the center line of Fourth (4th) Street and point of beginning. County Commissioners' District Number One (1) shall comprise Precincts numbered One (1) and Two (2).

COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT NO. 2

Beginning at the point where the prolongation of the center line of Fourth (4th) Street intersects with the low water mark of the Amelia River, thence proceed in a Southerly direction along the low water mark of the Amelia River to its intersection with the prolongation of the center line of Simmons Road, thence in an Easterly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Simmons Road to its intersection with the Fernandina Beach city limits, thence in a Northerly direction along the Fernandina Beach city limits and

continuing along the meanderings of Egans Creek to its intersection with the prolongation of the center line of Beech Street, thence in a Westerly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Beech Street to its intersection with the center line of Fourth (4th) Street, thence in a Northerly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Fourth (4th) Street to the low water mark of the Amelia River and point of beginning. County Commissioners' District Number Two (2) shall comprise Precincts numbered Three (3) and Four (4).

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DISTRICT NO. 3

Beginning at the point where the prolongation of the center line of Fourth (4th) Street intersects with the Amelia River, thence proceed in a Southerly direction along the low water mark of the Amelia River to its intersection with the prolongation of the center line of Simmons Road, thence in an Easterly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Simmons Road to its intersection with the low water mark of the Atlantic Ocean, thence in a Southerly direction along the low water mark of the Atlantic Ocean and continue along the low water mark of the Nassau Sound at the South end of Amelia Island to its intersection with the low water mark of the Nassau River, thence in a Westerly direction along the low water mark of the Nassau River to its intersection with a prolongation of center line of Interstate Highway No. Ninety-five (95), thence in a Northerly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Interstate Highway No. Ninety-five (95) to its intersection with the low water mark of the St. Marys River, thence in an Easterly direction along the low water mark of the St. Marys River and continue along the low water mark of the Cumberland Sound to its intersection with the low water mark of the Amelia River, thence in a Southerly direction along

the low water mark of the Amelia River to the prolongation of the center line of Fourth (4th) Street and point of beginning. County Commissioners' District Number Three (3) shall comprise Precincts numbered Five (5), Six (6) and Seven (7).

COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT NO. 4

Beginning at the point where the Range line between Range Twenty-four (24) East and Range Twenty-five (25) East intersects the Nassau-Duval County Line, thence proceed in a Northerly direction along said Range line to the Northeast corner of Section Twenty-four (24) Township One (1) North Range Twenty-four (24) East, thence in a Westerly direction along the Northern boundaries of Sections Twenty-four (24), Twenty-three (23) and Twenty-two (22) Township One (1) North Range Twenty-four (24) East to the Northwest corner of said Section Twenty-two (22), thence in a Northerly direction along the Eastern boundary of Section Sixteen (16) Township One (1) North Range Twenty-four (24) East to the Northeast corner of said Section Sixteen (16), thence in a Westerly direction along the Northern boundaries of Sections Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17), and Eighteen (18) Township One (1) North Range Twenty-four (24) East and continue along the Northern boundaries of Sections Nine (9) and Ten (10) Township One (1) North Range Twenty-three (23) East to the Northwest corner of said Section Ten (10), thence in a Northerly direction along the Eastern boundaries of Sections Six (6) and Three (3) Township One (1) North Range Twenty-three (23) East and continuing along a prolongation of the Eastern boundaries of Sections Thirty-four (34), Twenty-seven (27), Twenty-two (22) and fifteen (15) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-three (23) East (including a portion of Section Thirty-eight (38) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-three (23) East) to the intersection with the prolongation of the Southern

boundary of Section Eleven (11) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-three (23) East, thence in an Easterly direction along a prolongation of the Southern boundaries of Sections Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-three (23) East and continuing along the Southern boundaries of Sections Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-four (24) East and continuing along the Southern boundaries of Sections Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10) and Eleven (11) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-five (25) East to the Southeast corner of said Section Eleven (11), thence in a Northerly direction along the Eastern boundaries of Sections Eleven (11) and Two (2) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-five (25) East to the Northeast corner of said Section Two (2), thence in an Easterly direction along the prolongation of the Southern boundary of Section Thirty-six (36) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-five (25) East (the Township line between Township Three (3) North and Two (2) North) and continuing along the Southern boundaries of Section Thirty-one (31), Thirty-two (32), Thirty-three (33), Thirty-four (34), Thirty-five (35) and Forty-one (41) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-six (26) East to the intersection with the center line of Interstate Highway No. Ninety-five (95), thence in a Northerly direction along a prolongation of the center line of Interstate Highway No. Ninety-five (95) to the intersection with the low water mark of the St. Marys River, thence in a Westerly and then Southerly direction along the low water mark of the St. Marys River to its intersection with the Western boundary of Section Thirty-one (31) Township One (1) South Range Twenty-three (23) East, thence in a Southerly direction along the Western boundary of said Section Thirty-one (31) to the Southwest corner of the Section, thence in an Easterly direction along the Southern boundaries of Sections Thirty-

one (31), Thirty-two (32), Thirty-three (33), Thirty-four (34), Thirty-five (35), and Thirty-six (36) Township One (1) South Range Twenty-three (23) East to the Northeast corner of Section Thirty-six (36) Township One (1) South Range Twenty-three (23) East, thence in a Northerly and Easterly direction along the Nassau Duval County line to the Range line between Range Twenty-four (24) East and Range Twenty-five (25) East and point of beginning. County Commissioners' District Number Four (4) shall comprise Precincts numbered Eight (8), Nine (9) and Ten (10).

COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT NO. 5

Beginning at the point where the prolongation of the center line of Interstate Highway No. Ninety-five (95) intersects the low water mark of the Nassau River, thence proceed in a Westerly direction along the low water mark of the Nassau River and continue along the meanderings of Thomas Creek and the Nassau-Duval County Line to its intersection with the Range line between Range Twenty-four (24) East and Range Twenty-five (25) East, thence in a Northerly direction along said Range line to the Southeast corner of Section Thirteen (13), Township One (1) North Range Twenty-four (24) East, thence in a Westerly direction along the Southern boundaries of Sections Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), and Fifteen (15) Township One (1) North Range Twenty-four (24) East to the Southwest corner of said Section Fifteen (15), thence in a Northerly direction along the Western boundary of Section Fifteen (15) to the Southeast corner of Section Nine (9) Township One (1) North Range Twenty-four (24) East, thence in a Westerly direction along the Southern boundaries of Sections Nine (9), Eight (8) and Seven (7) Township One (1) North Range Twenty-three (23) East to the Southwest corner of said Section Seven (7), thence in a Northerly direction along the Western boundaries of Sections Seven (7) and Two (2) Township One (1) North Range Twenty-three (23) East and con-

tinuing along a prolongation of the Western boundaries of Section Thirty-five (35), Twenty-six (26), Twenty-three (23), and Fourteen (14) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-three (23) East (including a portion of Section Thirty-eight (38) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-three (23) East) to the intersection with a prolongation of the Northern boundary of said Section Fourteen (14), thence in an Easterly direction along the Northern boundaries of Sections Fourteen (14), and Thirteen (13) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-three (23) East and continuing along the Northern boundaries of Sections Eighteen (18), Seventeen (17), Sixteen (16), Fifteen (15), Fourteen (14) and Thirteen (13) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-four (24) East and continuing along the Northern boundaries of Sections Eighteen (18), Seventeen (17), Sixteen (16), Fifteen (15) and Fourteen (14) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-five (25) East to the Northeast corner of said Section Fourteen (14), thence in a Northerly direction along the Western boundaries of Sections Twelve (12) and One (1) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-five (25) East to the Northwest corner of said Section One (1), thence in an Easterly direction along the prolongation of the Northern boundary of Section One (1) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-five (25) East (the Township line between Township Three (3) North and Two (2) North) and continuing along the Northern boundaries of Sections Six (6), Five (5), Four (4), Three (3), Two (2) and One (1) Township Two (2) North Range Twenty-six (26) East to the intersection with the center line of Intersection with the center line of Interstate Highway No. Ninety-five (95), thence in a Southerly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Interstate Highway No. Ninety-five (95) to the Nassau River and point of beginning. County Commissioners' District Number Five (5)

shall comprise Precincts numbered Eleven (11) and Twelve (12).

RESOLUTION NO. 170

WHEREAS, Section 1 (e), Article VIII, of the Constitution of Florida provides that there shall be five County Commissioners Districts in each County, which Districts shall be numbered 1 to 5, inclusive, and shall be as nearly as possible equal in proportion to population; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of Florida has interpreted said Constitutional provision as permitting the County Commissioners a reasonable discretion in taking into consideration the practical aspects of the development of the County from an economic standpoint and has indicated that other practical considerations might be considered in dividing the County into County Commissioners Districts; and

WHEREAS, the growth of Nassau County since 1956 has resulted in an uneven distribution of the population within the County Commissioners Districts; and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that in view of the area population, and economic development of the County that the boundaries of the County Commissioners Districts for Nassau County should be established and defined as hereinafter set forth in this resolution.

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Beginning at the point where a prolongation of the center line of Fourth (4th) Street intersects with the low water mark of the Amelia River, thence proceed in a Southerly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Fourth (4th) Street to its intersection with the center line of Beech Street, thence in an Easterly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Beech Street to its intersection with the low water mark of Egans Creek, thence in a Southerly direction along the meanderings of Egans Creek and continue along the Fernandina Beach city limits to the intersection with a prolongation of the center line of Simmons Road, thence in an Easterly direction along the prolongation of the center line of Simmons Road to its intersection with the low water mark of the Atlantic Ocean, thence in a Northerly direction along the low water mark of the Atlantic Ocean to its intersection with the low water mark of the Cumberland Sound, thence in a Westerly direction along the low water marks of the Cumberland Sound and around the Northern end of Amelia Island to the intersection with the low water mark of the Amelia River, thence in a Southerly direction along the low water mark of the Amelia River to the prolongation of the center line of Fourth (4th) Street and point of beginning. County Commissioners District Number One (1) shall comprise Precincts numbered One (1) and Two (2).
