

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the County of Nassau has been placed in financial difficulties due to the inflationary costs in building construction, and

WHEREAS, its attempts to replace those damaged roads and bridges due to recent natural disasters have been somewhat thwarted because of the rising costs involved, and

WHEREAS, the funds available to the County are greatly limited, and

WHEREAS, an extreme hardship is placed upon the citizens of Nassau County because of the necessity of the expenditure of more funds than anticipated for the reconstruction of those bridges more particularly described in Appendix A hereto and made a part hereof.

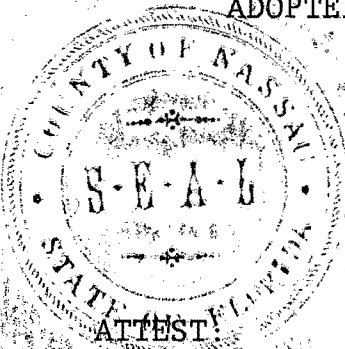
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Nassau County that the Department of Transportation of the State of Florida is urged to seek other State and federal funds for the completion of this most necessary work because the particular roads and bridges involved are major arteries not only to the citizens of Nassau County but the citizens of the State and Country as a whole.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such acts are begun immediately to allow said citizens the free and unobstructed use, once again, of these main arteries and thoroughfares.
