RESOLUTION REGARDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County to have a properly manned Emergency Rescue Service and

WHEREAS, in order to have a properly manned Emergency
Rescue Serivce it is of the utmost importance to have proper
insurance to protect the Emergency Medical Technicians who operate
this service and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has made inquiries regarding available insurance to cover the activities of Emergency Medical Technicians while in service and on call and

WHEREAS, the insurance quotes that are being processed on an emergency basis are not available at this time and

WHEREAS, under the police powers and other powers available to the County Commission under Chapter 125 of the Florida Statutes, it is fit and proper for the County Commission of Nassau County to support and indemnify those certified Emergency Medical Technicians who are properly trained and licensed in the County of Nassau and operate this service.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Commission to support and indemnify the licensed certified Emergency Medical Technicians while in service and on call in all their actions and decisions as long as all calls are answered and any diagnostic work done shall be confirmed by a licensed physician or practicising physician at a state certified hospital and all activities are performed in keeping with proper emergency medical procedures.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Gounty Commission of Nassau County does hereby support and indemnify the certified Emergency Medical Technicians while in service and on call in all their actions and decisions as long as all calls are answered and any diagnostic work done is confirmed by a licensed physician or practicising physician at a state certified hospital

and all activities are performed in keeping with proper emergency medical procedures.

THEREFORE be it further resolved, that this support and indemnity of licensed certified Emergency Medical Technicians shall be continued until proper insurance coverage may be purchased to cover and protect said technicians.
