RESOLUTION CLOSING THAT PORTION OFFICIAL RECORDS OF "OLD FERNANDINA-YULEE ROAD" A 40-FOOT RIGHT OF WAY, AS LIES WEST OF S.R. #107, AND EAST OF THE SOUTHERLY EXTENSION OF THE WESTERLY LINE OF PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN OFFICIAL RECORDS BOOK 21, PAGES 291 AND 292, PUBLIC RECORDS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, THIS PORTION BEING ADJACENT TO PROPERTY OWNED BY IDA ZETTEROWER AND BEING 250 FEET, MORE OR LESS. DESCRIBED LYING AND BEING A PORTION OF GOVERNMENT LOT 1 SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held at 2:45 p.m. o'clock on September 30th, 1975, at the Nassau County Courthouse in Fernandina Beach, Nassau County, Florida, pursuant to a Notice duly published as provided by law upon the Petition of Ida Zetterower, the unremarried widow of Arnold Zetterower, Sr., deceased, requesting this Board to close, vacate and abandon the Roadway or Alley-way hereinafter described and to renounce and disclaim the right of the public and the County in and to said Roadway or Alley-way described as follows:

The above described lying and being a portion of Government Lot 1, Section 27, Township 2 North, Range 28 East, Nassau County, Florida."

WHEREAS, no one appeared at said hearing to oppose said Petition, and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that said Roadway or Alley-way lies wholly without the corporate limits of any municipality and that this Board is authorized to close said Roadway or Alley-way by the authority granted in Section 336.09, Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that it is in the best interest of Nassau County and the Public that said Roadway or Alley-way be closed, vacated and abandoned and that the interest of Nassau County and the Public be renounced and disclaimed therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in meeting duly assembled that said Roadway or Alley-way as hereinbefore described in the preamble hereto be, and the same is, hereby closed, vacated and abandoned to the same extent as if said Roadway or Alley-way had never been delineated on said plat.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the right and interest of Nassau County and the Public in said Roadway or Alley-way above described be, and the same is, hereby renounced and disclaimed, and any easement heretofore owned, held, claimed or used by or on behalf of the public therein is hereby abrogated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Board shall cause to be published, within thirty (30) days after the adoption Beach News Leader Fernendma Nassau Cou of this Resolution, in one issue of the newspaper of general circulation published in Nassau County, Florida, a notice of the adoption of this Resolution closing, vacating and abandoning all of that certain Roadway or Alleyway being that portion of "Old Fernandina-Yulee Road", a 40-foot right of way, as lies West of S.R. #107, and East of the Southerly extension of the Westerly line of property described in Official Records Book 21, pages 291 and 292, public records of Nassau County, Florida, this portion being adjacent to property owned by Ida Zetterower and being 250 feet, more or less. The above described lying and being a portion of Government Lot 1, Section 27, Township 2 North, Range 28 East, Nassau County, Florida, and the renouncing and disclaiming of any right or interest of the County and the Public in said Roadway or Alley-way.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, did on September 30th, 1975, adopt a resolution closing, vacating and abandoning that certain Roadway or Alley-way described as follows:


