

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS
UPON PORTIONS OF COLSON ROAD, JOHNSON ROAD
AND ROBERTS ROAD IN NASSAU COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County Roads under Section 317.233(2), Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board, after full and careful investigation and in conformity to criteria promulgated by the State Road Department, has determined that in the best interest of public safety and welfare, the maximum limit on Colson Road, Johnson Road and Roberts Road be changed as follows: a maximum speed of twenty (20) miles per hour upon each stated road, and that clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits be posted in appropriate areas along said roads to adequately inform the public of said speed zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled, that the maximum speed limit of Colson Road, Johnson Road and Roberts Road be changed as follows: a maximum speed of twenty (20) miles per hour upon each stated road, and that the County Engineer is hereby directed to obtain clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits and to post such signs in appropriate areas along said roads to adequately inform the public of said speed zones.
