

R E S O L U T I O N NO. 77-181

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION TO TRANSFER MONIES FROM THE 032
BOND FUND TO THE COUNTY SECONDARY ROAD FUND PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Department of Transportation has previously
financed the purchase of Right of Way for A1A, which qualifies
as an 032 Bond Project, with Secondary Gas Tax Revenue, to
the extent of \$874,000, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Transportation sees economic
benefits in awarding three contracts simultaneously for the
total proposed construction work on SR-121, estimated at
\$561,000, and


WHEREAS, to accomplish these construction projects in
the immediate future, the Department of Transportation request
an interfund transfer of 032 bond monies to the Secondary Road
Fund program in the amount as needed, estimated to be \$167,000,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County
Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, duly assembled, that
the Department of Transportation is authorized to transfer funds
as needed from the proceeds of bond issue 032 to the Secondary
Road Fund, understanding that the estimated amount of transfer
will be 167,000.

Dear Mr. King:

As we discussed by telephone June 20, 1977, the SR-121 resurfacing projects were originally estimated to be \$450,000 including construction engineering and inspection.

However, the low bid received in May on this project, including C.E.I., was in the amount of \$617,000. This represents an increase of \$167,000 over our original estimate.

The low bid was reviewed by the Department and found to be satisfactory as to the scope of work and our updated bid prices. Since the secondary fund does not have a balance sufficient to support the increase we have asked the County, should they desire, for a resolution transferring \$167,000 from the 032 Bond Fund to the secondary fund in order to award the project.

As the secondary account balance builds, the transfer could be repaid, or one of the future bond jobs could be funded through the secondary account, in conjunction with any balance that may result from this job.
