RESOLUTION FOR THE LOCAL
GOVERNMENT COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING ACT ASSISTANCE
FUND PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County has recognized a need to provide for orderly growth and management as contemplated by the passage of the Florida Local Government Comprehensive Planning Act, and


WHEREAS, the State of Florida has recognized a need to assist local governments in availing themselves of the benefit of the Act, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has charged the Department of Community Affairs with administering the Local Government Comprehensive Planning Act Assistance Fund Program,

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County requests the Department of Community Affairs to include Nassau County's applications among those requesting financial assistance from the Local Government Comprehensive Planning Act Assistance Fund Program for 1977-1978.


