RESOLUTION FOR CLOSING OF ROAD 78-10

WHEREAS, W. L. HARDEE, has petitioned for the closing of road described as follows:

All that portion of the alley running Northerly and Southerly and lying between CASHEN LOTS 28, 29, 37, 38, 39, and 40, Southerly of and adjacent to the Easterly right-of-way line of old Fourteenth Street Extension (a 100.0' foot R/W), Northerly of and adjacent to the Westerly right-of-way line of new Fourteenth Street Extension (a 80.0' foot R/W), a subdivision of the SUSAN CASHEN GRANT, Section 30, Township 3 North, Range 28 East, Nassau County, Florida. As shown on the official map of the City of Fernandina (as lithographed and issued by the Florida Railroad Company in 1857 and enlarged, revised and re-issued by the Florida Town Improvement Company in 1887 and 1901).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners in regular meeting duly assembled that:

1. The alley-ways described above be vacated, abandoned, discontinued and closed, and the right, title and interest to the land described above shall pass and vest in accordance with Fla. Stat. §336.12 (1973).

2. Notice of the adoption of this resolution by the County Commissioners be published one (1) time within thirty (30) days of the date hereof in one issue of a newspaper of a general circulation published in this County.

3. Proof of the publication of notice of public hearing, this resolution as adopted, and the proof of publication of the notice of adoption of this resolution be recorded in the Public Records of this County.

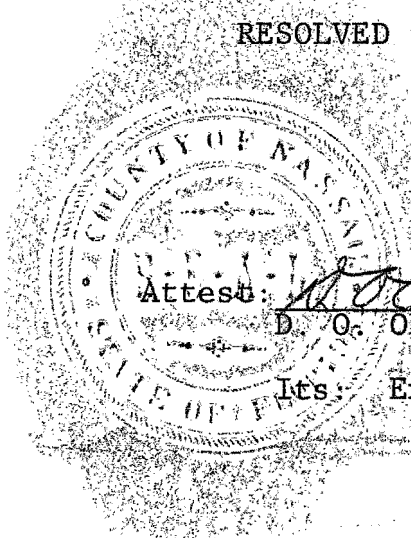
