

RESOLUTION # 78-33

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS
ON MUSSLEWHITE ROAD, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County Roads under Section 317.233(2), Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board, after full and careful investigation and upon the recommendation of the County Engineer, has determined that in the best interest of public safety and welfare, the maximum limits on Musslewhite Road running northerly from U.S. 301 (S.R. 15) be established as follows: a maximum speed of thirty (30) miles per hour beginning at MP 02.8 and ending at MP 03.0 and then Resume Safe Speed and that clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits be posted in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zone.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled, that the maximum speed limit on Musslewhite Road be established as follows: A maximum speed of thirty (30) miles per hour beginning at MP 02.8 and ending at MP 03.0 and then Resume Safe Speed.
