

RESOLUTION # 78-36

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON EDWARDS FISH CAMP ROAD, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County Roads under Section 317.233(2), Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board, after full and careful investigation and upon the recommendation of the County Engineer, has determined that in the best interest of public safety and welfare, the maximum speed limits on Edwards Fish Camp Road running southerly from A1A be established as follows: a maximum speed of fifty-five (55) miles per hour from MP 0.00 and ending at MP 0.85 and then begin forty-five (45) miles per hour through to MP 1.35 and then begin thirty (30) miles per hour through to the end of pavement and that clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits be posted in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zones.

NOW, ~~THEREFORE~~, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled, that the maximum speed limit on Edwards Fish Camp Road be established as follows: A maximum speed of fifty-five (55) miles per hour from MP 0.00 and ending at MP 0.85 and then begin forty-five (45) miles per hour through to Mp 1.35 and then begin thirty (30) miles per hour through to the end of pavement.
