WHEREAS, the engineers, relying upon said approved map of location and survey, have completed right of way maps and determined the necessary properties needed for final construction,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County
Commissioners of Nassau County hereby approves the right of way
maps of the above described Section as the official right of way
maps of said project and finds that all of the right of way, borrow
pits and drainage easements as outlined on said maps are necessary
for the final construction and maintenance of said project, including any designated access rights of property not actually taken, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following property description
