

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON
C-115, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County Roads under Section 317.233(2), Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board, after full and careful investigation and upon the recommendation of the County Engineer, has determined that in the best interest of public safety and welfare, the maximum speed limits on C-115 running southerly from Henry Smith Road approximately 4.25 miles to the Dyal Road or the end of the new project be established as follows: a maximum speed of fifty (50) miles per hour from Henry Smith Road southerly to the Dyal Road or end of new project and that clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits be posted in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled, that the maximum speed limit on C-115 be established as follows: a maximum speed of fifty (50) miles per hour from Henry Smith Road southerly to the Dyal Road or end of new Project.
