RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON MUSSLEWHITE ROAD, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County Roads under Section 316.1898(2), Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, This Board, after full and careful investigation and upon the recommendation of the County Engineer, has determined that in the best interest of public safety and welfare, the maximum speed limits on Musslewhite Road running from U.S. 1 easterly be established as follows: a maximum speed of forty-five (45) miles per hour from M.P. 0.00 and ending at M.P. 2.00 and that clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits be posted in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled, that the maximum speed limit on Musslewhite Road be established as follows: A maximum speed of forty-five (45) miles per hour from M.P. 0.00 and ending at M.P. 2.00.
