

RESOLUTION NO. 80-29 *A*
NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the CITY COUNCIL of the CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, has proposed imposing a tax on the residents of Nassau County and other persons not residing in Duval County but working in Duval County; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of this Board that such legislation would be extremely unfair in that the residents of Nassau County expend great sums of money annually on various goods and services in Duval County, all of which operates to the benefit of the residents of Duval County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled:

1.) That the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, does hereby oppose any such legislation as proposed by the CITY COUNCIL OF JACKSONVILLE that would impose any tax on the residents of Nassau County working in Duval County.
