OPPOSING RULE 41 OF CHAPTER 427 F.S. TRANSPORTATION OF THE DISADVANTAGED

WHEREAS, the duly constituted Legislature of the State of Florida enacted Chapter 427 of the Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, Section 427.012 F.S. provides for a Coordinating Council of the Transportation Disadvantaged, and

WHEREAS, Section 427.013 F.S. mandates the Coordinating Council "to foster the coordinating of transportation services provided to the transportation disadvantaged", and

WHEREAS, Section 427.013 (6) F.S. further requires the Council to "assist communities", and "special emphasis shall be placed on working with rural communities", and

WHEREAS, the Coordinating Council has proposed Administrative Rule 41-1-.01 through 41-1-.09 to implement Chapter 427 F.S., and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, fully endorses and supports a "coordinated plan" for the transportation needs of all County citizens, and

WHEREAS, the proposed rule goes beyond "the statutory interest" of providing for coordinated transportation service, and

WHEREAS, the proposed rule places excessive and unnecessary standards which if approved, would eliminate services by virtue of the economic constraints placed upon not only Nassau County, but any other interested rural County throughout the State of Florida.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, disagrees with the proposed "specific requirements" of Chapter 41-01, of the Florida Administrative Rules, and requests the Coordinating Council reject the proposed rule as written.
