

RESOLUTION 82-1

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE NASSAU COUNTY COUNCIL ON AGING AS THE NASSAU COUNTY TRANSPORTATION PROVIDER FOR THE DISADVANTAGED INDIVIDUALS OF NASSAU COUNTY AS STATED IN CHAPTER 427, FLORIDA STATUTES.

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Council on Aging has the expertise and is presently the main provider of transportation for the disadvantaged of Nassau County, and

WHEREAS, it is essential for the disadvantaged of Nassau County that they receive expert care and transportation and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 427, Florida Statutes, a transportation provider for Nassau County must be designated so as to contract with the Department of Transportation for the transportation of the disadvantaged,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in regular meeting duly assembled that the County hereby designates the Nassau County Council on Aging as the area-wide transportation provider for the transportation of disadvantaged individuals, pursuant to Chapter 427, Florida Statutes.

FURTHER, that the Nassau County Council on Aging contract directly with the Department of Transportation.
