

RESOLUTION 82-17

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING OF THOSE CERTAIN RIGHTS-OF-WAY OR ALLEYS IN THE HEREIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY, AND THE RENOUNCING AND DISCLAIMING OF ANY RIGHT OR INTEREST OF SAID NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND THE PUBLIC IN SAID RIGHTS OF WAY OR ALLEYS.

WHEREAS, TOM WELLS, has petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, to close, vacate and abandon and to renounce and disclaim the right and interest of Nassau County, Florida, and the public in and to those certain rights-of-way or alleys described as follows:

All those portions of right-of-way being and lying in St. Marys Highlands Subdivision recorded in Plat Book 5, page 13, of the Official Records of Nassau County, a portion of Section 41, Township 4 North, Range 23 and 24 East, Nassau County, Florida, more particularly described as follows:

- (a) Walker Road in its entirety, lying and directly adjacent to Blocks 1, 2 and 3 of the above-described subdivision.
- (b) All that part of River Road right-of-way that lies West of a line which is the elongation of the Westerly right-of-way of Hagan Road, which said line has a bearing of N26°46'W.
- (c) All that part of St. Marys Road right-of-way that lies West of a line which is the elongation of the Easterly property line of Lot 4, Block 3 and said line having a bearing of North 26°46'W.

WHEREAS, Section 336.09, Florida Statutes, authorizes this Board to close, vacate and abandon streets, roads and alleys and to renounce and disclaim the right and interest of Nassau County, Florida, and the public in and to lands delineated on any recorded map or plat as a street, alley, road or highway outside of the corporate limits of any municipality after given notice of and holding a public hearing to determine whether such action should be taken.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in a meeting duly assembled that a public hearing will be held on said petition at the Nassau County Courthouse Annex Building in Fernandina Beach,

Florida, on the 15th day of June, A.D. 1982, at
2:30 o'clock p.m.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of said meeting be published in the Fernandina Beach News-Leader, a newspaper of general circulation in Nassau County, Florida, at least two weeks prior to the date of said hearing, said notice to be in substantially the form as indicated on the attached.
