

RESOLUTION NO. 82-39

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTES, INITIATE A SURVEY OF THE NAVIGABLE WATERWAYS OF NASSAU COUNTY TO DETERMINE THE NEED FOR NO-WAKE AND SPEED ZONES.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare for the citizens of Nassau County that speed zones and no-wake zones be established in the navigable waterways of Nassau County, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is specifically concerned with the navigable waterways adjacent to Fort Clinch State Park to and including the area in the waterways adjacent to the "Sandbar Restaurant", and

WHEREAS, the Department of Natural Resources, by statute, has the authority to conduct surveys and establish no-wake and speed zones; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the Department of Natural Resources conduct said survey and establish the above described zones if it is found to be in the best interests of the citizens of Nassau County.
