BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that the Clerk of Circuit and County Court is authorized to file with the Board of County Commissioners in lieu of the report required by Chapter 142.03, Florida Statutes, a report showing the amount of fines and forfeitures paid into his office for the month and the year-to-date. Said report to be made at the end of each month.
