A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE ACQUISITION BY THE STATE OF FLORIDA OF 38.6 ACRES ON AMELIA ISLAND, FLORIDA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARK AND RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has a "Save Our Coast" program, and

WHEREAS, as part of the "Save Our Coast" program, the State purchases properties for park and recreational purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida recognizes the need to provide public properties, and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has advised the County of Nassau that properties on Amelia Island are under consideration for acquisition by the State,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that:

- 1.) They endorse the acquisition of 38.6 acres presently held by SENIOR CORP., further described in the attached Exhibit "A".
- 2.) After acquisition by the State, the County will maintain said property for the residents of Nassau County.
- 3.) The maintenance of the property may include creation of a park facility.
- 4.) The County shall commit up to \$50,000.00 as their contribution towards the purchase of said property and the moneys may be raised from a bond issue.
- 5.) The County would expect to provide the funds for acquisition within twelve (12) months of the State's approval to purchase the property.
