## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE STATE OF FLORIDA'S PROPOSED ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY PRESENTLY OWNED BY PLM ENTERPRISES AND LOCATED ON THE ATLANTIC OCEAN AND MARSH ON THE SOUTHERN TIP OF AMELIA ISLAND, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, pursuant to its "Save Our Coast" program, has notified the County of Nassau that the above property is being considered for acquisition by the State as a park, and

WHEREAS, the County of Nassau endorses this action with the following qualifications:

- 1.) The State shall advise the County of any preliminary proposals regarding the acquisition and use of the PLM lands and the County shall have the right to make recommendations regarding said proposals prior to their being submitted to the Cabinet.
- 2.) The County and the State immediately enter into negotiations towards the goal of providing the County control of all PLM lands on the Nassau Sound and the Atlantic Beach, measured from the high water mark.
- 3.) The County shall be granted access roads through the PLM property for a thru-way to the Atlantic Beaches.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County does hereby approve the acquisition of the above-stated property with the qualifications listed above.
