

RESOLUTION 83-36

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO ADOPT, PURSUANT TO
FLORIDA STATUTES, CHAPTER 206, A TWO CENT
GASOLINE TAX.

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has provided, pursuant to
Florida Statutes, Chapter 206, for the levy of an additional
gasoline tax, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County,
Florida, endorses the intent of Florida Statutes, Chapter 206,
and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County
has determined that there is a need for additional transportation
expenditures within the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County
Commissioners of Nassau County hereby resolves to enact an
Ordinance levying a two cent (2¢) local option gasoline tax and
said hearing on this Ordinance shall be held during the month of
July, 1983.
