

RESOLUTION 83-4

A RESOLUTION COMMITTING A PORTION OF THE FIFTH (5th) AND SIXTH (6th) CENT GAS TAX FUNDS FOR 1983/1984 TO THE FUNDING OF THE CRAWFORD INDUSTRIAL PARK.

WHEREAS, the County of Nassau had previously applied for and received a grant for the development of an industrial park, and

WHEREAS, the County of Nassau must expend certain moneys in order to prepare the site and qualify for the grant moneys, and

WHEREAS, the development of an industrial park is in the best interests of the citizens of Nassau County, and

WHEREAS, the fifth (5th) and sixth (6th) cent gas tax funds are state moneys that are guaranteed to the County each and every month of every year,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners hereby commits the sum of \$105,900.00 to funding the Crawford Industrial Park, said amount being derived from the fifth (5th) and sixth (6th) cent gas tax fund for fiscal year 1983/1984.

RESOLVED this 9th day of February, 1983, in regular session at the Nassau County Courthouse Annex, Fernandina Beach, Florida.
