A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE TIME LIMITS FOR
DEVELOPMENT FOR THE PUD AS INDICATED IN
ORDINANCE NUMBER 80-12.

WHEREAS, the Developer has advised the Board of County Commissioners that, due to economic conditions, the development as indicated in Ordinance No. 80-12 has not begun, and

WHEREAS, the Board determined that the phasing schedule cannot be accomplished, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners granted an extension of Ordinance No. 80-12 for a period of one year, and

WHEREAS, the Board has been made aware of the developers request to extend the phasing schedule for a period of $2\frac{1}{2}$ years, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, welfare and morals of the citizens of Nassau County that the development proceed as a Planned Unit Development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the phasing schedule is hereby extended for a period of two and one-half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) years from this date with the provision that the Developer keep the County advised as to the exact date development will begin.

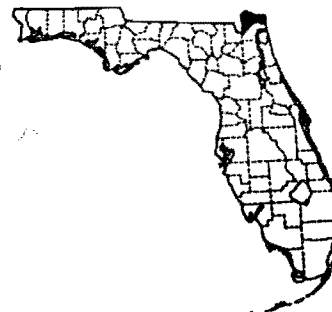
