AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN A REGIONAL PLANNING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM - FY 83/84

WHEREAS, the federal government and the State of Florida have made available funding to the Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council (NEFRPC) for undertaking a regional planning assistance program for the seven county (Region IV) northeast Florida region, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the seven counties within the northeast Florida region (Baker, Clay, Duval, Flagler, Nassau, Putnam, and St. Johns) agree to jointly participate in a regional comprehensive planning program in order to avail themselves of these financial contributions, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed by the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners that participation in a joint effort with other counties in the region is necessary and desirable if the region is to develop in an orderly and efficient manner, while protecting its natural resources,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners hereby express its intent to participate financially with the other six counties in the region in undertaking a regional comprehensive planning program, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners hereby agrees to contribute as its share of the cost of said program for FY 82/83 the sum of \$ 5,177 , which represents Nassau County's fair and equitable share of the \$ 70,000 of local financial participation supplementing the federal and state Planning Assistance monies, and to appropriate in its FY 83/84 budget for said purposes.

FY 83/84 ANNUAL BUDGET, AND LOCAL COUNTY MATCHING SHARE

The Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council, established via interlocal agreement pursuant to Chapter 160, F.S. by the counties of Baker, Duval, Clay, Nassau, Putnam, Flagler and St. Johns, adopted its FY 83/84 work program and budget at a regular meeting held on July 14, 1983. As you will note from the attached material, the majority of the funding is coming from state and federal sources; however, a local contribution of \$70,000 is requested by the Council to supplement these funds for use within the region.

The Council discussed alternative methods of distributing the local contribution among the seven counties within the Northeast Florida Region. It was agreed that the fairest method would be to continue to allocate the local share as follows:

- Duval County's allocation would be determined by estimating the cost of completing the work program within Duval County: \$33,893
- 2. The balance of the local match (\$36,107) would be shared on a per capita basis by the other six counties in the region using the official July 1, 1982 population estimates prepared by the University of Florida.

Based upon this formula, the Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council respectfully requests that each of the seven counties within the region authorize and appropriate in their FY 83/84 budget the amount indicated for your county, as follows:
