RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FILING OF APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, STATE OF FLORIDA, FOR A GRANT UNDER THE TERMS OF THE FLORIDA RECREATION DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.


